## ORDINANCE NO. 05-2020

A ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARION, TEXAS, ABANDONING A 20' ALLEY LOCATED WEST OF ITS INTERSECTION WITH CUNNINGHAM STREET AT THE MARION INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT (MISD) PROPERTY LINE AND CONTINUING THROUGH MISD PROPERTY, AS SHOWN ON THE RECORDED PLATS OF THE CITY OF MARION, GUADALUPE COUNTY, TEXAS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council has made aware that it currently owns a 20' alley that is partially located on property owned by the Marion Independent School District (MISD) where the Norma Krueger Primary School currently exists;

WHEREAS, MISD has placed improvements including the main school building on the right-of-way and intends to place improved surface on the right-of-way to control traffic through campus as part of its expansion process;

WHEREAS, the City received the request from MISD to abandon the portion of 20' alley located on the campus;

WHEREAS, this portion of the 20' alley is not currently used as a public road and is contained entirely on the lot owned by MISD; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City of Marion to abandon for public use the requested portion of the 20' alley; NOW THEREFORE,

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARION AS FOLLOWS:

## SECTION 1:

THAT, the portion of 20' alley running west from Cunningham Street through the Marion Independent School District property where Norma Krueger Primary School is located, as shown on the attached map (Exhibit A) and recorded with the County Clerk of Guadalupe County, is hereby closed and abandoned for public use.

## **SECTION 2:**

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage.
